1. What is the **output** of the following Python program? Remember that variable assignments and updates do *not* produce output – only print statements do. You may want to make some notes to keep track of those variables, so clearly label what is scratch work and what is output.

```
user = "Inara"
k1 = 3*2
print("Hi", user)
print("Level", k1)
k1 = k1 + 2
print("k1")
```

2. The following Python program uses conditional statements (if/else). What is its **output?** Again, clearly label what is scratch work and what is output.

```
xy = 5
zq = 3
print(xy*2)
if xy > 7:
    print("yes")
else:
    print("no")
print(xy + zq)
```

3. This question is about scheduling tasks on the CPU in an operating system. We'll use **batch** processing, which means that once we start a task, we will run it to completion without interruption. There are two ways to select the next task to run: First-come, first-served (FCFS) and Shortest job first (SJF).

Calculate the **average turnaround time** for scheduling the following jobs using both FCFS and SJF.

Job	Time
J1	3
J2	8
J3	2
J4	4
